



We are excited to offer you a new health benefit – Doctor On Demand.

Doctor On Demand connects you face-to-face with a board-certified doctor (typically within minutes) or licensed psychologist (by appointment) on your smartphone, tablet or computer through live video. No more waiting rooms, telephone hold music or ER visits for most nonemergency medical issues!

If you are participating in the health plan, Doctor On Demand medical visits are \$10 per visit. Visits with a psychologist are \$25 for 25 minutes and \$35 for 50 minutes. Psychiatric 45 minute initial visit is \$35 and \$25 for a 15 minute follow-up visit.
