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PEBP Board Approves Plan Year 2020 Premiums

On March 28, 2019, the PEBP Board met to approve rates for Plan Year 2020.

Monthly premiums for the statewide Consumer Driven Health Plan (PPO) will remain the same as this current plan year. The Northern Nevada PEBP Premier Plan (EPO) as well

as Southern Nevada Health Plan of Nevada (HMO) will see a slight decrease in their monthly premiums.

PEBP will have the final rates available to view in the new E-PEBP portal as well as on the Open Enrollment section of the PEBP website by May 1st.

Mandatory Smart90 Pharmacy Network—CDHP

The Smart90 Pharmacy network allows members to save money on their 90-day supply of maintenance (long-term) medications.

Effective July 1, 2019 members enrolled in the CDHP will be required to have their 90-day supply of prescription medications filled through Express Scripts home delivery or through a Smart90 participating retail pharmacy. Pharmacies

such as Walgreens and CVS are **excluded** from the Smart90 network, however many other retail chain pharmacies, such as Costco and grocery store pharmacies remain in the network.

New PEBP Member Portal

Log into your new E-PEBP portal account to access all of your PEBP benefits!

Beginning April 15th, members will experience a new and improved member portal. Beginning May 1st, you will be able to enroll in a medical plan, change your plan selections, enroll in many of the new voluntary products and view all of your plan related documents.

Members will also be able to directly upload any required supporting documents into their account and have the ability to send and receive secure messages to PEBP member services.

New Voluntary Benefits

PEBP has provided voluntary benefits on a limited basis for many years which includes buy-up life insurance for members and their families, short term disability, automobile, home, and renters insurance, and long term care insurance.

Starting May 1, 2019, PEBP participants will be able to select and enroll in multiple new voluntary benefits that will become effective on July 1, 2019. These benefits include:

- Accident, Critical Illness and Hospital Indemnity Plans

- Identification Theft Protection
- Legal Plan Provisions
- Auto, Home and Renters Insurance*
- Pet Insurance*
- Buy-Up Vision Plan



Full details on these programs are available on the new E-PEBP Portal during Open Enrollment in May.

Even if you have chosen to decline your PEBP health insurance benefits, you can still sign up for these voluntary benefits.

*You will be able to enroll in these voluntary benefits beginning July 1, 2019 with an effective date of August 1, 2019.

Enhanced HSA/HRA Funding for the CDHP

As of July 1, 2019 if you are the primary participant enrolled in the Consumer Driven Health Plan (CDHP) additional enhanced funds are available to be added to your Health Savings Account (HSA) or Health Reimbursement

Arrangement (HRA). The Board approved \$400 CDHP HSA/HRA enhanced funding for Plan Year 2020.

You can receive \$100 just by completing four preventive activities.

You can also receive an additional \$100 by registering for Doctor on Demand and taking the Healthcare Bluebook Guided Tour. If you have already completed these two activities in a previous

plan year, you will not be required to complete these again.

The additional \$200 will be automatically applied to your HSA or HRA account at the beginning of Plan Year 2020.
