Renown's free-standing labs are considered hospital-based labs. However, in accordance with the Master Plan Documents:

"If a free-standing, non-hospital-based outpatient laboratory facility is not available within 50 miles of your residence, you may use a hospital-based laboratory facility or hospital-based draw station."

Routine and preventive lab work is considered:

- Routine blood work that is part of receiving quality, comprehensive medical care.
- Preventive laboratory services such as but not limited to basic metabolic panel, lipid, or general health panel.

As a member living in the zip-codes above, an exception is made so you may use the Fallon Renown location for lab services. However, if you travel to Reno, Carson City, or any other location you must use an in-network free-standing laboratory facilities such as LabCorp, Quest, etc.

This does not affect pre-admission testing within seven days of an inpatient admission or outpatient surgery.
