VOLUNTARY BENEFITS ARE CHANGING

Dear PEBP Member,

Effective 01/01/2022, the Public Employees' Benefits Program (PEBP) is changing Enrollment and Eligibility systems.

This means:

- THERE WILL BE A SPECIAL ENROLLMENT FOR VOLUNTARY BENEFITS
- SOME VOLUNTARY BENEFITS WILL TERMINATE
- THERE WILL BE A NEW PORTAL FOR PEBP MEMBERS TO LOG INTO

Be on the lookout for future emails with more information about our new Enrollment and Eligibility system.

Special Enrollment for Voluntary Benefits:

Voluntary Benefit Special Enrollment will be **11/8/2021 through 11/19/2021**. Any voluntary benefit elections or changes during this time will become effective 01/01/2022.

During this Special Enrollment Period, you will be able to review options and enroll in voluntary products via our new benefit platform, Benefitplace. We have some new vendors offering voluntary benefits and some old vendors that will no longer be partnered with PEBP effective 1/1/2022.

- **Accident, Critical Illness and Hospital Indemnity** coverage will now be offered by **The Standard**.
 - Overall rates are comparable or even reduced, and enhanced benefit options are offered.
- New **Voluntary Long-Term Disability** offered by **The Standard**.
 - If you enroll during this Special Enrollment Period, there will be no medical questions! *This is the one and only time medical questions will not be asked so take advantage now!*
- Special enrollment window to elect coverage for **VSP Vision** Base or Buy Up plans for you or your eligible dependent effective 1/1/2022 to 6/30/2022. You may not cancel a current policy.
- Additional **LegalEase** legal plan offering more affordable rates and enhanced options for existing plan.
 - *Those currently enrolled in LegalEase will retain current coverage unless you change your plan selection during this special enrollment.*
- Those newly electing or already enrolled in **ID Watchdog Identity Theft Protection** will see a 15% rate reduction from current plan rates starting 1/1/22. *Current enrollees do not need to act.*
- **Liberty Mutual Home/Auto** will no longer have a group discount and plans will be moved to direct billed. If you would like to cancel your plan please call 1-844-825-5816.
- **Nationwide Pet** is open for new enrollees! *Current enrollees of Nationwide Pet do not need to act.*
- **There will be no Voluntary Life or Voluntary Short-Term Disability (STD) options during this Special Enrollment period.** Coverage will be maintained as currently elected. You can sign up for Voluntary Life and STD at any time with a waiting period and evidence of insurability is required.



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Voluntary Benefits That Will Terminate:

The below plans will no longer be offered through Corestream, our prior vendor for voluntary benefits. To maintain coverage, **you will need to** call the carrier directly by 12/31 or your plan will terminate

- AFLAC – active employees: 1-855-901-1100, retired employees: 1-877-467-8933
- ASPCA – 1-877-343-5314
- METLIFE HOME/AUTO – 1-800-438-6381
- AGIS/UNUM Long Term Care (LTC) * – 1-877-485-2318

*LTC will no longer be offered through AGIS, formally known as UNUM, effective 1/1/22. You will need to contact **AGIS directly** to maintain coverage. If you currently have a policy with AGIS please contact 1-877-485-2318. AGIS will also be sending portability information to existing members.

IMPORTANT: Members will only be able to access the new platform, Benefitplace, from 11/8/2021 through 11/19/2021. From 11/20/2021 to 12/31/2021, members will need to continue using their E-PEBP Portal, as the new platform will only be available for this voluntary benefit special enrollment period.

How to Access Benefitplace, the new E-PEBP Portal:

1. Enter <https://www.secure3-enroll.com/go/nvpebp> into your browser or access the Benefitplace platform under the [What's New](#) section of PEBP's website, and you will be directed to the below login screen.

2. Click *Create an account* to begin the account creation process.
3. Please view the Benefitplace Self Registration and Login guide under the What's New Section of PEBPs website for more information.
4. This will be your username and password for the new E-PEBP portal going forward effective 1/1/2022.
